Questions to ask	Things to think about
1. WHO?	<ul> <li>Author is clearly identified</li> <li>Author is an expert in this area</li> <li>Contact information is listed</li> <li>A reliable organization is connected to this web site</li> </ul>
2. WHAT?	<ul> <li>Purpose of the web site is clear</li> <li>Site explains the topic thoroughly</li> <li>Information is easily read and understood</li> </ul>
3. WHY?	<ul> <li>Site presents a balanced point of view, rather than pushing a particular perspective</li> <li>The point of view is fair</li> <li>Site does not contain advertising</li> </ul>
4. WHEN?	<ul> <li>Date of creation/update is available</li> <li>The information is current</li> <li>All links work</li> </ul>
5. HOW?	<ul> <li>Facts stated can be checked and confirmed using other sources</li> <li>Site is free of errors</li> <li>Site is easy to navigate</li> </ul>
