

HURON HEIGHT'S PROM 2016 STUDENT CONTRACT AND RECEIPT

Huron Heights Secondary School is hosting their 7th annual Senior Prom *Thursday, May 26th 2016* from 6:30pm until 10:30pm. The prom will take place at **Hacienda Sarria, 1245 Union Street** in Kitchener, Ontario. All students attending Prom must have a student card and a completed and signed **student contract**. The student contract must be returned to the school at the time of ticket purchase. You **cannot** buy a ticket without a contract. The cost of each ticket is **\$60**.

The use and/or possession of alcohol or illegal drugs are not permitted at Waterloo Region District School Board events. All students must submit to a pat down bags, purses and coats **will** be checked at the door by security, police and/or administration. If the staff supervising the Prom has reason to believe that a student and/or his/her guest has consumed or is in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs before or during the Prom, the student and his/her guest shall not be permitted to enter or remain at the Prom.

EVENT POLICIES

- **Zero tolerance for alcohol or drugs** of any kind is permitted at the school sponsored event.
- If you are suspected to be under the influence or in possession of any alcohol/drugs or behaving inappropriately (such as fighting etc.) consequences will involve: being denied entry or asked to leave the venue, the possibility of suspension and the possibility of being charged by the police. All students **must** submit to a security pat-down and breathalyzer test, if required.
- There is **no entry after 8 pm**. Also, once you leave the Prom you may not return. **No re-entry and no exceptions!**
- There is absolutely **No smoking** on the premises of the venue, even if you are of legal age.
- Students must be dressed appropriately. **No jeans or T-shirts. A formal dress code is in effect.**
- **ALL** bags, purses and coats are subject to inspection before entering the venue by security, police, or administration.
- Neither Huron Heights nor the venue is responsible for any lost or stolen items checked in at the coat check desk.
- **ALL** guests **must** be preregistered for the event and present a valid secondary school student card or government issued identification at the door. No exceptions! **Bring your ticket and Identification to be admitted to Prom.**
- **Limousines are allowed** at the Prom as long as the following conditions are met by all: Absolutely no drinking or alcohol present in the limo. If security decides that there was alcohol in the limo, or that any person in the limo has consumed alcohol or drugs before the event, all occupants of the limousine will be turned away from the event and parents notified.
- If a student sponsors a guest, **the student and guest must arrive together**. Huron students are responsible for the behaviour and actions of the guest.
- Refunds will **not** be issued to students who are refused entry for failing to adhere to the policies listed above.
