

Online Student Planner App

This year students will not receive a planner/agenda. Instead, Huron Heights now has an 'App' with the planner embedded in it.

Features of the App include:

- The ability for students to manage day-to-day agenda through notes, to-do lists, or picture notes
- Subscribable 'channels' for teams, clubs, and eventually classes - staff members can send messages (notifications) to their subscribers (similar to Remind 101)
- Links to the school website, twitter, and school information
- Major events listed on the calendar and timetable changes for assemblies already embedded.
- Sometime this year the App will integrate Google Apps

The App is now available in the App Store (iPhone) and Google Play (Android). **You can locate the App by searching for 'HHSS'. Please download the App and browse its features!**

Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Open your iPhone App Store or Android Google Play Store
2. Search for "HHSS"
3. Download the App for free
4. Students should click on the question mark button on the bottom left side of the screen for instructions on how to navigate the app
5. Students can click on the circular gear on the bottom right side of the screen to load in their classes and colour code them
6. The Main Menu is on the top left side of the screen
7. Students will be able to subscribe to "Channels" for specific clubs and teams. Staff sponsors/coaches can provide the students with the respective codes.

FAQ:

Q: What if I can't find the App when I search for it in the store?

A: Try searching for 'Honeygarlic Software' and scroll through the available schools.

Q: What if I have a Blackberry?

A: At <http://honeygarlic.ca/download.php> are links to the App on both App Stores as well as a direct download link for the Android version – this can be used to install on Blackberry 10 devices and Android phones that don't have Google Play.

Q: What if I don't have a phone? Can I buy a planner from the school?
