Student Behaviour

Students share in the responsibility of creating a successful learning environment. At Huron Heights students are expected to:

Be present and be on time

Regular and punctual attendance is an important factor in achieving academic success. Students are expected to attend classes regularly and to follow established attendance validation procedures.

Be prepared

Students are expected to arrive at every class with the required materials as specified by their teachers.

Be respectful and safe
